Review Minutes from the November 30<sup>th</sup> Meeting

**Topic of Discussion: Speaker (sexting, cyber bullying and physical violence)**

- Natalie Hlavenka emailed Anne Sibley, with the Collin Count Juvenile Detention Center about the possibility of her speaking to our high school, and middle school students. We are asking she speak to the students about sexting, cyber bullying and physical violence along with the legal and long term consequences that then actions could have.
- Anne emailed a confirmation of the speaking engagement.
- Presentation is scheduled for **Friday, February 24<sup>th</sup>** (high school will begin at 8:30 am and middle school will follow.
- The SHAC committee would like the 5<sup>th</sup> grade students to attend as well, but a letter of permission needs to be home and signed in order them to attend.
- Natalie will draft a permission slip for the 5<sup>th</sup> grade students and will send it to administration for approval. (Attached)
- The SHAC committee also decided we would like to have a google form questioner given to the students for feedback. Results and students opinions will be shared at the next meeting.

**Topic of Discussion: Community Event (Hawk Color Run and all information so far)**

- The committee has decided to plan the “Hawk Color Run” as our 2016-2017 community event
- The color run will take place on Saturday, April 8<sup>th</sup> on the Hawkins ISD campus. Registration will begin at 8:30am and the race will start at 9:30am as discussed by the committee. The committee agreed to a fee of \$15.00 being charged for entry into the race. We also discussed and agreed on a family of 5 discount for \$60.00 (Flyer attached)
- Natalie has put together a flyer and registration form that has been approved by administration. Dr. Crawford would like to have the Chamber of Commerce east egg hunt added to the flyer for advertisement. The Chamber will also advertise our event.
- We will use the Hawkins ISD school website, face book page, marquee and flyers sent home with students to advertise the race.
- Volunteers: We will speak to PTO and maybe some students who need community service hours along with any Jarvis students who may want to help.

- Sponsors: We need to come up with a sponsor letter to ask for “color station” sponsors. Sponsors will be charged \$100 to have a station set up on the 5k course. As the runners pass the station they will be doused with color. Sponsors will be verbally mentioned during morning announcement at the event along with signs at their stations.
- Natalie will work on the letter and send it to administration for approval.
- Timing: I have emailed Coach Wilson and Sarah Deller about how to time the runner successfully. I have not received a return email.
- Course: Will speak with maintenance about mapping a course for the 5K. They helped Sarah Deller in the past with cross country. (attached)
